

2020 MONSTER HYDRO STADIUM BLITZ CHAMPIONSHIP GUIDELINES

WELCOME TO THE 2020 MONSTER HYDRO STADIUM BLITZ CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES! THE WORLD'S BEST OBSTACLE COURSE RACE (OCR) ATHLETES WILL HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO COMPETE IN A 12-RACE SERIES, CULMINATING AT THE MONSTER HYDRO STADIUM BLITZ CHAMPIONSHIP. BELOW ARE THE OFFICIAL RULES AND GUIDELINES PERTAINING TO THE CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES.

THREE CHAMPIONSHIP DIVISIONS

- ⇒ Individual Males
- ⇒ Individual Females
- ⇒ COED TEAMS OF 5

AVAILABLE QUALIFYING SPOTS

- \Rightarrow 60 Individual Males 5 racers at each of the 12 qualifying events
- ⇒ 60 Individual Females 5 racers at each of the 12 qualifying events
- \Rightarrow 60 Coed Teams 5 teams at each of the 12 qualifying events

ELIGIBILITY

- ⇒ PARTICIPANTS CAN QUALIFY DURING ANY MONSTER HYDRO STADIUM BLITZ HEAT AT ALL QUALIFYING RACES.
- \Rightarrow Racers are not required to compete in the "Competitive" start time to qualify.
- ⇒ RACE PARTICIPANTS CAN QUALIFY BOTH AS AN INDIVIDUAL AND A TEAM MEMBER DURING THE SAME EVENT.
- ⇒ TEAMS MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF FIVE (5) MEMBERS TO QUALIFY FOR TEAM SCORING
- \Rightarrow Teams must have at least one (1) representative of each gender to Qualify.

INDIVIDUAL QUALIFICATIONS

- ⇒ Points will be the determining factor for placement.
- \Rightarrow In the case of a tie for points, the faster time will be a tie breaker.
- ⇒ Top 5 individual racers at each event will qualify for the national championship.
- ⇒ IF ONE OF THE TOP 5 RACERS HAS ALREADY QUALIFIED AT A PREVIOUS RACE AND ACCEPTED ENTRY TO THE MONSTER HYDRO STADIUM BLITZ OCR CHAMPIONSHIP, THE NEXT ELIGIBLE QUALIFIER WILL BE SELECTED, AND SO ON UNTIL 5 UNIQUE RACERS ARE SELECTED FROM EACH EVENT.
- \Rightarrow If one of the top 5 racers declines their invitation, the next eligible racer will be selected until 5 are chosen.

TEAM QUALIFICATIONS

- ⇒ Points will be the determining factor for placement.
- ⇒ A TEAM'S SCORE WILL BE DETERMINED BY ADDING UP THE POINTS ACCUMULATED BY THEIR FIVE (5) HIGHEST SCORING TEAM MEMBERS. MUST INCLUDE AT LEAST ONE (1) REPRESENTATIVE OF EACH GENDER.
- \Rightarrow In the case of a tie for points between teams, the faster cumulative time will be a tie breaker.
- \Rightarrow The top 5 teams at each event will qualify for the national championship.
- ⇒ IF ONE OF THE MEMBERS OF THE TOP 5 TEAMS HAS ALREADY QUALIFIED AS A MEMBER OF A TEAM AT A PREVIOUS RACE AND ACCEPTED ENTRY TO THE NATIONAL TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP, THE TEAM'S SCORE WILL BE ADJUSTED TO REPRESENT THE SCORES OF THE TOP 5 ELIGIBLE RACERS.
- \Rightarrow If one of the top 5 teams declines their invitation, the next eligible team will be selected until 5 teams are chosen.
- \Rightarrow The team that races in the championship must be comprised of at least f 3 of the original f 5 top team members.
- → THE FOURTH AND FIFTH RACERS ON THE CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM CAN BE CHOSEN FROM ANY TEAM MEMBER THAT COMPETED ON THE TEAM IN THE ORIGINAL QUALIFYING RACE.
- ⇒ TEAMS MUST BE COMPRISED OF AT LEAST 1 MEMBER OF EACH GENDER.
- \Rightarrow A racer can only qualify with one (1) team.

SELECTION PROCESS

- ⇒ SELECTED INDIVIDUAL RACERS & TEAMS WILL BE NOTIFIED VIA EMAIL NO MORE THAN THREE (3) DAYS AFTER THE EVENT.
- \Rightarrow Selected individual racers & teams will have seven (7) days after their offer to accept or deny their acceptance.
- ⇒ Official qualifiers will receive a unique code to gain access to private registration in the championship event start time.
- \Rightarrow You do NOT need to be present at the qualifying event awards ceremony to receive your placement.
- ⇒ There will be no waitlist for the Championship races, but in the case a qualifying racer declines acceptance, the next qualifying racer will be deferred entry.
- \Rightarrow A racer can decline a championship invitation and choose to accept an invitation at later race.

ADDITIONAL RULES

- ⇒ Individual racers who also qualified as part of a team may elect to race both in the Individual Championship race AND in the Team Championships. The racer is required to start during the individual Championship start time. Their score will count towards their championship team score.
- \Rightarrow Scores will be determined by point acquisition from obstacle completion and timing bonuses.
- \Rightarrow ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST COMPLETE OBSTACLES ON THEIR OWN. TEAM MEMBERS CANNOT ASSIST EACH OTHER.
- \Rightarrow Successful obstacle completion varies by obstacle, as stated in the rules and scoring (*see below)
- ⇒ EACH RACER MUST ADHERE TO MONSTER HYRDRO STADIUM BLITZ RULES AND SCORING.

- ⇒ RACE DIRECTORS AND EVENT OFFICIALS HAVE THE RIGHT TO DISQUALIFY ANY RACER.
- ⇒ Any race participant deemed to have cheated during the competition will receive a ban on participating competitively at any future Monster Hydro Stadium Blitz OCR Championship event. Appeals must be submitted to contactus@stadiumblitz.com
